<b>RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS</b>	
<b>Coordinating Instructions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Shooting on this range has no effect on any other ranges</li> <li>2. A Suitably Qualified Experienced Person (SQEP) is to be appointed as the responsible RO when shooting on Bay A</li> </ol> <b>Rifles and Pistols</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Maximum of 8 lanes <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Special requirements for NRA competitions</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <b>Shotguns</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Slug <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Maximum 4 lanes. 1 x firer within each section</li> </ol> </li> <li>5. Shot size No4 – SG <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Maximum 3 lanes. 1 x firer on 3 LH sections</li> </ol> </li> </ol>

Minimum engagement distance: 10m</li> </ul> <p>8. <b>Shotguns Positions Permitted:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Slug <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Sitting</li> <li>ii. Kneeling</li> <li>iii. Standing</li> <li>iv. Benched</li> <li>v. Engagement distance: 20m only</li> </ul> </li> <li>b. Shot size No4 – SG same as Pistols</li> <li>c. Shot size No5 or smaller shot <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Sitting</li> <li>ii. Kneeling</li> <li>iii. Standing</li> <li>iv. Benched</li> <li>v. Minimum engagement distance: 5m</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>9. Changes of position are permitted within any detail or practice outside competition providing all firers follow the same sequence, and in competition in accordance with the conditions</p> <p>10. Fire and movement (i.e. changing location during a detail with a loaded firearm) is permitted with shotguns, only if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. The movement area is clearly delineated by objects or markers that do not constitute a trip hazard</li> <li>b. No movement up range is involved</li> <li>c. Only one firer is on the range at a time</li> </ul> <p>11. During practical shooting when shooting through an aperture, the muzzle of the firearm is to protrude completely through the aperture</p>
<p><b>Targetry</b></p>	<p>12. <b>MAX TCH:</b> 1.5m</p> <p>13. Ricochet inducing material used to construct practical courses of fire is to be fully protected sufficiently to prevent ricochet</p> <p>14. <b>Hard Targets:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Permission to shoot at hard targets is to be requested at the time of booking</li> <li>b. Minimum engagement distance: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. 7m: No4 shot or smaller (excluding NRA specific events)</li> </ul> </li> <li>c. Users are not permitted to provide their own hard targets</li> <li>d. Hard targets to be placed within area defined by red</li> </ul>

	<p>marker on the bullet catcher defence wall</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>e. Hard targets to be placed no more than 1m up range from the bullet catcher defence wall</li><li>f. Hard targets are to be placed so not to damage range infrastructure</li></ul> <p>15. Unless prior permission has been obtained from the CE only targets from the NRA approved set may be used</p> <p>16. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and /or appropriate shooting station or peg. Any deviation from this is to be notified, in writing, and approved by the Range Services Manager</p> <p>17. Clay pigeons are not to be engaged within Winans Range</p>
