# Updates

- All bookings must be pre-booked online
- Walk-in bookings are permitted, however, the online booking must still be created
  - The range office can create the booking for you on the day or over the phone if paying at the time
- Bookings must be paid on the day of or prior – cash is not accepted
- Amendments to bookings must be made personally as a change request, or via email – no phone calls please!

# Update – Chobham Ridge

- 2 firing points now available  
CANNOT be used concurrently
- 8 people plus mandatory NSC RO
- Shooting approx. 0930 - 1530
- £525 until high season 2023

### TARGET RIFLE SHOOTERS

Note: When fallbacks occur including 300x, shrouds will not be put on to reduce the size of the aiming mark/target due to resource commitments

You must ensure all rifles are zeroed prior to using the electronic targets as sensitive electronic equipment may be damaged by inaccurate shooting.

The user will be liable for any damage caused to the electronic targetry

ShotMarker – **PLEASE TURN OFF MOBILE DATA WHEN USING**

Please report any fault with an electronic target immediately to Range Control

If shots are not registering, cease shooting

Do not move yourself to another lane



- When booking please select one of the following options (\*range\* may vary):
  - ‘\*Century\* Electronic’ to be for specific hourly slot
  - ‘\*Century\* Electronic (Session)’ to be for the whole AM/PM session
  - Selecting the wrong option may mean you are incorrectly charged
- If wanting multiple distances then you will need to book separate hourly slots rather than a session, unless it is a specified fallback date

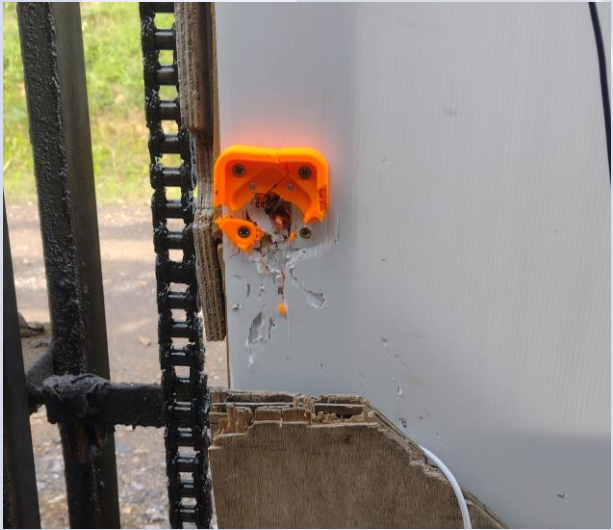

# PROCEDURES



**Range Safety Boards are there for a reason!**

**DO NOT IGNORE OR MOVE THEM!**

**Firearms are not to be on the point before shooting commences or the Hooter sounds at 0830 and 1330!!**

**Do not remove a loaded firearm from the firing point, if you have a round stuck in the chamber contact Range Control by radio or mobile**

# Targetry

- Please do not put own Targetry on top of NRA targets – request a blank target in your booking and ensure targets are kept to the pin on area
- Target Centre Height – range designed based on aim at centre of target
- May be subject to additional charge for making targets unusable



# Signing on to the Range & Radios

- Mandatory requirement for RO to sign the sheet outside the back of the range office

- Pay attention to radio allocation
- **DO NOT TAKE ANY RADIO**
- If you are unsure please ask the range office
- Electronic Targets - Radios will be on the firing point
- \*\* indicates radios will be shared with other lanes



# Zero Range

- Use of the zero range is for on the day only – not in advance
- Required to sign in at the range office
- Affiliated club members can use it the day of and day prior to their booking
- HME – 3 clear shots need to be identifiable

## Blow off shots/Running in a barrell

- Permitted as long as it is not busy
- Still required to sign in at the range office
- Still required to pay zero range fee for use of facilities



# Bookings

**Guest Days are to be notified to Surrey Firearms Licensing Department**

- Must also select tick box on booking application form

**Membership and Shooter Competency Card (SCC) must be on you at all times**



**Markers**

- NRA Markers receive a full day of training and must pass an assessment before being hired
- We aim to provide minimum of 25 markers each Saturday and 15 on a Sunday (due to age restrictions)
- Priority will be given to competitions and Stickledown

### **Cancellation of Markers**

- When bookings are cancelled we have to retract work already allocated
  - If this happens on numerous occasions we lose marker reliability and they begin to look elsewhere for weekend work. Please give us as much notice as possible if cancelling
- 
- Communication with markers – keeping your marker updated on the situation (breaks/change of shooter/falling back) ensures a better working relationship
- 
- Many markers will attempt to give feedback so keep your radio switched on

## Reporting Issues

- Contact Range Control at the time of issue (not after finishing)
- Busy periods supervisors are in butts
- Full time staff can attend to problems in Century/Short Siberia
- We will provide markers with further training if deemed necessary
  
- If we are struggling to source markers we will aim to notify you 4 days prior, if you choose to cancel you will not be subject to the cancellation policy
  
- We cannot guarantee markers will turn up on the day. We will aim to provide an electronic target as an alternative
  
- Please be aware you may still be charged for the target hire if your marker fails to show on the day



## **Non NRA Markers are the Responsibility of the Club/Booker**

- The club/member will be accountable for any damage caused by non NRA markers - including loss of radios
- Access to Stickledown is latest 08.15 and 13.15
- Please ensure your marker(s) has their own access into the butts. During busy periods vehicle access may be restricted
- We will not delay shooting waiting for markers to arrive

Any issues contact Range Control immediately. If they are unsure of the procedure please see control for a brief.

# Cancellation Policy

## **Worked well for 2022**

- Number of targets reduced up until 1<sup>st</sup> September – 475
- Targets charged for 50% as per 3-6 week cancellation policy – 37
- Targets charged for 75% as per 3 week of less cancellation policy - 8
- All others reduced outside cancellation policy and incurred no fee

**Weekends Low Season (1 Jan – 26 Mar & 29 Oct – 31 Dec) and Weekdays (1 Jan – 31 Dec) – 3 days or less charged at full rate**

**Weekends High Season (27 Mar – 28 Oct) – Bookings of 5 or less Targets – 4 days or less charged at full rate**

**Weekends High Season (27 Mar – 28 Oct) – Bookings of 6 or more Targets on Century, Stickle-down & Short Siberia**

Bookings cancelled/reduced within 6 weeks of the shooting weekend will be liable for the following:

- More than 6 weeks before of the shooting weekend: any changes made to the booking\* are non-chargeable
- Targets cancelled/reduced with 3 to 6 weeks' notice before the shooting weekend: 50% of the booking\* is chargeable
- Targets cancelled/reduced with 1 to 3 weeks' notice before the shooting weekend: 75% of the booking\* is chargeable
- Targets cancelled/reduced with less than 1 weeks' notice before the shooting weekend: 100% of the booking\* is chargeable
  
- When cancellations/reductions result in a % of the booking being chargeable, the balance payment is due at time of cancellation/reduction.
- *\*Booking: Following a reduction of targets, the revised amount of targets becomes the booking. Any further cancellations/reductions will apply to the revised booking.*

**Bookings taken within the cancellation period will be:**

- Subject to the cancellation policy
- Accepted on Butt Zero, Winans, Cheylesmore and Melville (exc Bay A), only if providing own Targetry unless resources permit otherwise

# 2023 - Fall backs

## Timings

If 2 distances being shot the fall back will be approx. half way through session (10.30 or 15.30)

If 3 distances being shot the fall back will be approx. every hour

Range Safety will liase with all clubs during the early part of the session to establish approx. timings

Note: Largest competition will have priority and overall RO Responsibilities, but will still be subject to NSC Staff approval



# 2023 - Fall backs

## Effect

Century LHS can only be used when we have priority over other users on site. These dates coincide with large competition requests. Due to this, if there is no competition taking place, then there will be no fall back permitted in advance.

1 week prior to the date we may be able to permit independent fallbacks on the right hand side of the range but this will be subject to availability.

IF YOU ARE HAPPY FOR A SINGLE DISTANCE PLEASE STATE THIS IN THE COMMENTS AS WE WILL BE ABLE TO CONFIRM SOONER. YOU CAN THEN CHECK FALLBACK AVAILABILITY NEARER THE TIME.


# 2023 – Bookings

Online system opens 1<sup>st</sup> November

Jan/Feb bookings & pre-arranged major club competitions authorised initially
